HARVEST:

Stone Creek Chardonnay is made from 100% Mendocino County grapes from the Weibel Family H&W Estate Vineyards. The 2008 vintage was produced from selected lots from specific Chardonnay blocks in the vineyard. Mendocino County is renowned for its crisp and fruity chardonnay that has an elegant balance and is full of flavor.

Mendocino County has warm days like Napa Valley and Sonoma County but cooler nights, which accentuates the delicate flavor nuances in the grapes, as well as promoting a refreshing crispness. Our H&W Estate Vineyards captures that classic Mendocino County character superbly in the grapes grown there.

TASTING NOTES:

Fermentation in 100% stainless steel tanks creates a style that captures the bright, fresh flavors of Mendocino County Chardonnay. Our 2008 Chardonnay has a lovely hue of gold with beautiful clarity. It has aromas of white peach and ripe nectarine. With a moderate weight and balance, flavors of juicy white grapes and stone fruits makes our 2008 Stone Creek Chardonnay a natural with a multitude of dishes. Try it with grilled chicken, soft cheeses, and vegetarian entrées.
